ABOUT THE SHOW

Chitty Chitty Bang Bang was originally a family favourite film, released in 1968.



The stage version was first performed on Broadway in 2005. While the story is similar, the stage version is much slicker with more comedy elements added.

The story is set In England, around 1910. Eccentric widower, Caractacus Potts works as an inventor, a job which barely supports himself, his even more eccentric father, and his two children, Jeremy and Jemima. When the children beg their father to buy for them their favourite plaything - a broken-down jalopy of a car sitting at a local junkyard - Caractacus determines to do whatever he can to make the money to buy it. His first scheme involves the unexpected assistance of a pretty and wealthy young woman they have just met named Truly Scrumptious, the daughter of a candy factory owner, but when this scheme goes wrong, Caractacus eventually comes up with another plan, which gives him enough to buy the car.

Applying his inventing skills, Caractacus transforms the piece of junk into a beautiful working machine, which they name Chitty Chitty Bang Bang, due in no small way to the loud noise its engine makes. Meanwhile Baron Bomburst has decided he wants the car and assigns his two spies, Boris and Goran to steal the car and bring back to him in Vulgaria. Their hair- brained scheme to kidnap the inventor goes wrong when they kidnap Grandpa Potts instead.

Determined to rescue their father/grandfather, Caractacus and the children, along with Truly, fly to Vulgaria where they find themselves in a land with no children. Baroness Bomburst hates children with a passion and sends the child-catcher to eradicate any children.

Discovering some children who have been rescued from the clutches of the child-catcher in the sewers of Vulgaria, Caractacus, Truly and the local toy-maker hatch a plan to give Vulgaria back their children while at the same time rescuing their father/grandfather.

No unavailability is permitted during Tech (from 4th April 2026) as performers are required to be present for all scenes.





Who We're Looking For

The Kings Theatre is committed to inclusive casting that reflects the diversity of our community. We welcome performers of all backgrounds, genders, and ethnicities.

- Adults: Must be aged 18 or older on audition day
- **Children**: Must be aged 9–15 (at least 9 by audition day, and no older than 15 on 19 April 2026)

Registration

- The closing date for compulsory audition registration is end of day, Sunday 21
 September 2025
- The Kings Theatre reserves the right to close applications early if audition numbers exceed available audition spaces.
- You must register via the Kings website. No other way of registering will be accepted. Confirmation: You'll receive venue and time details after registering if an audition is available for you.
- You will then be contacted with details of the venue and time for auditions.
- Parents/guardians: If you have more than one child auditioning, you must complete a separate form for each child

Audition Day - Sunday 5 October 2025

- Auditions will take place throughout the day
- Children: Times will be confirmed but will start from 9am, we expect to conclude the ensemble auditions by 1pm. If recalled for either Jeremy or Jemima Potts, you will be expected to return in the late afternoon and stay until the early evening
- Adults: If confirmed to attend arrival times will be sent to you and will be from 1pm, if auditioning for a principal role, please be prepared to stay until the early evening.
- Late arrivals will not be admitted, as this disrupts other auditionees.
- Be prepared to stay all day—recalls will be held the same day for selected performers.

- Taking photos or videos during the audition process is not permitted.

Children's info

Please note that all children selected **MUST** be available for all rehearsal dates and all assigned shows. This means that some dates may require time off school. By applying to audition, you as parent/guardian agree to this.

Please note the evening shows will end at around 9.30pm.

Non-attendance at rehearsals without the prior agreement of the Production Team will result in your child being withdrawn from the show. Agreement for absence will only be given in exceptional circumstances with evidence of the emergency provided. The Producer's decision on this will be final.

Licensed chaperones will be appointed for rehearsals and the performances. If any parent/guardian who has a child performing would be interested in volunteering to become a licensed chaperone, details of how to apply for a license can be found on the relevant council websites.

Who we are looking for

• The Production Team will be casting two teams of children. The teams will perform in rotation over the 13 performances. Teams will be assigned show dates after the audition.

Audition day information

- Parents/Guardians will drop off their children and remain on site. You will be informed if your child has been recalled.
- Children
- Please be prepared to be available all morning as recalls will be held for those selected from the first round of auditions. If this is the case, you will be informed of what time to return for the recall. Jeremy and Jemima's need to be available all day.
- If your child is selected, you will have to provide all the information required for licensing within a week of accepting.
- The Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) and Head Chaperone will be Rebecca Henderson.
